- Round trip transportation via private motorcoach equipped with reclining seats and restroom
- Full day guided tour with experienced Harriet Tubman guide – In the morning, you'll take a driving tour of Cambridge, MD including historic High Street, Long Wharf and the Courthouse. On the tour you'll learn about slave trading in the area and hear stories of escapes. In the afternoon, you'll travel along the Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad Byway. It is the only place in the world that preserves and interprets the places where Harriet Tubman was born, lived, labored and where she fled from.
- Visit to the Harriet Tubman Underground Railroad Visitor Center – Exhibits feature information about Harriet's childhood and young adulthood, living and laboring under slavery in Dorchester County and neighboring Caroline County.
- Visit to the Bucktown Village Store – the site of Harriet Tubman's first act of defiance, which nearly ended her life.
- Full-course lunch at the Portside Restaurant, Cambridge, MD. Menu includes: Garden Salad, Choice of Entrée – Crab Cake or Grilled Chicken Breast, Baked Potato, Roll & Butter, Dessert, Beverage.
