

## Voting Information for November Election

The last day to register to vote for the November 3 General Election is October 19, 2020. You can register to vote at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com).

Registered voters can choose to vote by mail or in person. Those who wish to vote by mail can apply for a ballot at [www.votespa.com](http://www.votespa.com). The counties plan to begin mailing ballots in late September. ***If you intend to vote by mail, you should apply for a mail-in ballot as soon as possible.*** In Delaware County, each polling location will have a secure drop box on election day for completed mail-in ballots on Election Day. Montgomery County has not yet finalized their mail-in drop box locations.

If you requested a mail-in ballot for the spring primary election and checked the box indicating a permanent Annual Mail-In Ballot Request, you will automatically receive a ballot for the November election.

Those who plan to vote in person should be aware that ***polling locations may have changed*** due to staffing levels. Delaware and Montgomery Counties have not yet finalized their voting locations, however, you can continue to check for updates at <https://www.pavoterservices.pa.gov/pages/pollingplaceinfo.aspx>.

The contests on the November 3 ballot include: U.S President, U.S Congress, State Attorney General, State Auditor General, State Treasurer, State Senate, and State House.
